

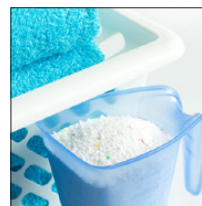


TAED (Tetra-acetythylenediamine)



TAED is the activator of bleaching agent SPC (Sodium Percarbonate) and having the following advantages:

- Activates hydrogen peroxide bleaching agent in temperature range of 40 to 60 °C
- Removes coloured stains from fabrics
- Removes unpleasant odours
- Provides a high hygiene standard of the wash
- Dye transfer inhibition
